The Manchester Conference Centre is a purpose built conference venue and hotel facility in the heart of Manchester City Centre, 300 metres from Manchester Piccadilly Station.

How to find the Conference Centre (Sackville Street, Manchester M1 3BB)

- The Manchester Conference Centre is only 3 minutes walk from Manchester Piccadilly Railway Station for National and International rail services.
- Manchester Airport can be reached by train, taxi or hire car in 15 minutes
- By road, just off the A57M Mancunian Way at the A34 exit, with rapid links to the motorway network, including the M6, M56 and M1
- It is adjacent to a 700 space multi story car park which is open seven days a week
- Manchester Oxford Road Station, a convenient train station for delegates travelling from the North West is just 3 minutes walk
- 5 Minutes by train from Manchester Victoria Railway Station
- Convenient Metrolink trams are available in Manchester Piccadilly Gardens and Manchester Piccadilly Station; both only 3 minutes walk away.
